
Galaxy S II LTE (SGH-I727R) Recovery Mode



How to reset Samsung Galaxy S II LTE (SGH-I727R)

Warning: all data on the phone is lost after reset



- 2. Use the Volume button to highlight "wipe data/factory reset" and press the Home (Android 2.3.5) or Power (Android 4.0.4) button to select.
- 3. Use the Volume button to highlight 'Yes – delete all user data' and press the Home (Android 2.3.5) or Power (Android 4.0.4) button to select.
- **4.** You're back to the main screen. Highlight 'reboot system now' and click the Home (Android 2.3.5) or Power (Android 4.0.4) button to select.


The reboot takes 5 minutes.

1. Turn the phone off. Press and hold **Volume up & down**, and **power** at the same time to enter into the recovery mode. Let go of both buttons when you see the <u>Galaxy S II LTE</u> logo or when it vibrates.
