2 Software extensions

The following functional extensions were added in PLUS V9.1B over version V9.1A:

An operand has been added to the statement TY55. (CR 243/91)

TY55 W:

A warning is sent when trying to load a pkey too long for the device on which PLUS is running.

3 Technical information

3.1 Resource requirements

The following resources are required for PULS V9.1B:

- 1. Virtual memory: ca 70 KByte dynamic
- 2. Static disc space: ca 70 KByte
- Dynamic disc space Space necessary to save the Pkeys format into an object library when asked.
- 4. Special hardware: None

3.2 Software configurations

PLUS V09.1B runs on BS2000 V09.5A up.

3.3 Product installation

Installation userid

The PLUS product may be installed on any userid. The only necessary file is the PLUS phase.

3.4 Product use

To start PLUS V09.1B, use the following command:

/START-PROGRAM PLUS or /EXEC PLUS

3.5 Obsolete functions (and those to be discontinued)

No function has been eliminated

3.6 Incompatibilities

The operand W is now accepted for the statement TY55.

3.7 Restrictions

None

3.8 Procedure in the event of errors

If an error occurs when working with PLUS V09.1B, you should prepare the following documentation: the device type on which PLUS was running and a procedure to reproduce the error condition.

The supported hardware is the same as in previous version.
