42% of Australian businesses currently do business outside of their own country. Businesses in Austria, Singapore and North Africa export to the most number of countries, at an average of 3.8 countries whilst businesses in Australia export to an average of 1.7 countries.

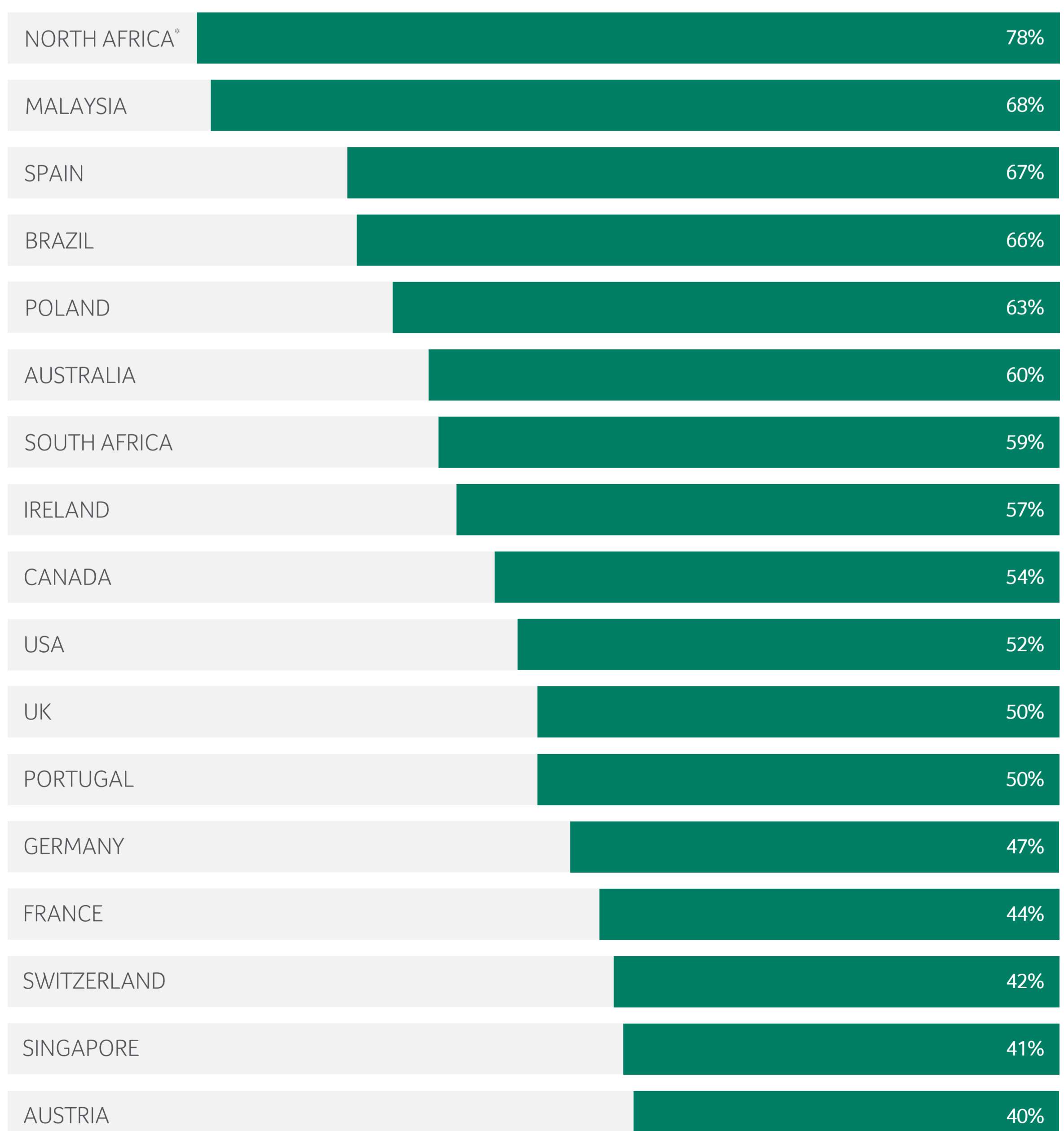
